Candidates File for City Elections in November

Eleven people have filed to run for West Columbia city council seats in the upcoming election on November 5, 2013. All four incumbents have chosen to run for re-election and three face challengers. A special election drew four candidates to fill the unexpired term in District Four. The candidate filing period closed at 5 p.m. on Friday, August 9, 2013.
