The City of West Columbia will receive Sealed Bids for the Riverside Water Treatment Plant Flood Damage Repair project until 2:00 PM on July 11, 2018 at the West Columbia City Hall at 200 North 12th Street, West Columbia at which time and place all Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

Bids are invited upon the several items and quantities of work as follows: furnishing all materials, equipment and labor necessary for the construction of a reinforced concrete retaining wall at the Riverside Water Treatment Plant. The project consists of the construction of an approximately 30-foot long reinforced concrete retaining wall including sediment and erosion control, excavation and backfill, concrete forming and placement, installation of helical piers for support of the wall, site stabilization, and all appurtenances as specified and depicted in the Contract Documents.

No bid shall be considered unless the bidder is legally qualified under the provisions of the South Carolina Contractor's Licensing Law. A certified check or bank draft payable to the order of the OWNER, negotiable U. S. Government Bonds (at par value), or a satisfactory Bid Bond executed by the Bidder and an acceptable Surety in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the total Bid shall be submitted with each Bid. Attention is called to the fact that not less than the minimum salaries and wages as set forth in the Contract Documents must be paid on this project as applicable. The Contractor shall ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, color, religion, sex, or national origin.

OWNER reserves the right to reject any and/or all Bids or to waive any informalities in the Bidding. Bids may be held by the OWNER for a period not to exceed ninety (90) days from the date of the opening of Bids for the purpose of reviewing the Bids and investigating the qualifications of Bidders, prior to awarding of the Contract.
