INVITATION TO BID

Sealed Bids will be received by the City of West Columbia (Owner) at the Owner's office at the West Columbia City Hall, 200 North 12th Street (New Brookland Room), West Columbia, South Carolina until 2 p.m., local time, on November 27, 2018 for Lake Murray WTP Disinfection Improvements & Clearwell Piping Realignment.

At said place and time, and promptly thereafter, all Bids that have been duly received will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The proposed Work is generally described as follows:

The project will include realignment of the filtered water piping to allow Clearwell Nos. 2 and 3 to operate in series with Clearwell No. 1; the installation of new baffle curtains in Clearwell Nos. 1 and 2 to increase the retention time of filtered water through these clearwells; the installation of new chemical feed vaults which will be used to feed sodium hypochlorite (NOCL) and liquid ammonium sulfate (LAS); and the installation of new chemical feed pumps, valves, piping, and accessories at the West Columbia Lake Murray Water Treatment Plant located at 730 Old Cherokee Road in Lexington, South Carolina.

All Bids must be in accordance with the Bidding Documents on file at the office of the Engineer, Black & Veatch Corporation, 1411 Gervais Street Suite 402, Columbia, South Carolina 29201.

If the Contract is to be awarded, Owner will give the Successful Bidder a Notice of Award within the number of days set forth in the Bid Form for acceptance of the Bid.
