## **Fire Department Bay Wall Coatings Bid**

The City of West Columbia and the West Columbia Fire Department is accepting bids until Thursday April 4, 2019 from qualified contractors to clean and coat with acrylic epoxy the walls and door frames of the apparatus bays at the fire department. The work is to be done at the West Columbia Fire Department, located at 610 N. 12<sup>th</sup> Street, West Columbia, SC 29169. The following is a detailed listing of the work that shall be done.

### **Existing CMU Walls and Associated Existing Metals**

Surface Preparation: Power wash the entire exterior surface using 3,500 PSI with a rotating turbo nozzle to remove all loose paint, dirt and foreign matter. Great Lakes Laboratories Extra Muscle Prepaint Cleaner, CHLOR\*WASH or similar shall be used prior to power washing to help remove all the existing contaminants. Feather back all loose edges to a smooth and tight transition. After painting caulk door frames and CMU wall transitions. The surface shall be clean and dry before painting.

1<sup>st</sup> Coat: Waterborne Acrylic Epoxy applied at 4.0 – 6.0 dry mils.  
(performance equal to Tnemec Series 113 Tneme-TufCoat)

2<sup>nd</sup> Coat: Waterborne Acrylic Epoxy applied at 4.0 – 6.0 dry mils.  
(performance equal to Tnemec Series 113 Tneme-TufCoat)

The coating shall consist of two colors, a base color and a stripe color. The stripe shall be a 32” wide stripe that runs all the way around the bay and is centered between the ceiling and floor. The base color shall be Stone Mountain (10GR) and the stripe color shall be Crawford Red (21RD). All other decals and door markings shall be coated over. The work shall be done while still allowing the fire department to utilize a portion of the bay area as work is being performed, as this is the only fire station the city operates. Contractors shall include in bid the projected job completion time and how they propose to work with the fire department while walls are being cleaned and coated. Bid shall also include a one-year workmanship and manufacturer warranty for completed work.
