City of West Columbia's Parade of Lights Entry

Are you in the middle of your Christmas shopping list? If you are, make sure you check out the many opportunities for unique Christmas gifts and activities in West Columbia.

This year, there will be three Holiday Meeting Street Artisan Markets with over 25 vendors each Saturday in the Interactive Art Park, 425 Meeting Street, West Columbia. The Holiday Markets will be held the first three Saturdays in December from 11 AM - 3 PM, on December 2, 9, and 16. Vendors at the markets include painters, candle-makers, leather workers, jewelry makers, produce growers, photographers, bakers, and

2nd Annual Parade Day, from 12 PM – 4 PM, and the Parade of Lights beginning at 5:30 PM, Saturday, December 9. The North Pole, at the CWC Chamber Building, 1006 12th Street, will have live music by Blackwater Hwy, family activities, and shopping.

West Columbia's Triangle City, Sunset Boulevard Corridor, US 1 Corridor, and the River District are perfect places to shop with local store owners this season. Be sure to get your WECO Christmas tree ornament at State Street Trading Co. on State Street. West Columbia is decorated for the holiday season. The City of West Columbia hosts the 19th Annual Christmas Tree Lighting on Friday, December 1, at City Hall. A kayak Christmas Tree is in Riverwalk Amphitheater, Carraway Park has Santa's Mailbox and a holiday canoe, and the Interactive Art Park is dressed for the season.

Santa's Mailbox is back in the City of West Columbia and is located at Carraway Park, 212 Hudson Street, West Columbia. Children can bring their letters or use the provided postcards at Santa's Post Office and drop them in Santa's mailbox. Santa's mailbox accepts letters until December 13, for a response by Christmas. The mailbox will accept letters through December 24.

Bill's Music Shop and Pickin' Parlor, 710 Meeting St.

Bill's Music Shop and Pickin' Parlor is host to national live Bluegrass bands. Located at 710 Meeting Street, in West Columbia, Bill's Music Shop and Pickin' Parlor has a long-standing history of presenting high-quality bluegrass performances in a family atmosphere.

Bill Wells founded Bill's Music Shop and Pickin' Parlor, with his wife Louise, in 1985. He offered Friday night Bluegrass jam sessions.

The response to the jam sessions was overwhelming and Bill's Music Shop and Pickin' Parlor have added more features and grown over the years. The shop sells guitars, banjos, and other stringed instruments. Bill's is licensed to sell Gibson and Martin brands. The venue's concert hall is large and well-known among professional

musicians throughout the Southeast. After Bill's passing in 2011, Willie Wells, Bill's son, took over Bill's Music Shop and Pickin' Parlor.

"We want to carry on that same spirit and love for music that my father fostered," said Willie. Every Friday night at Bill's features the Legendary Bluegrass and Acoustic Open Stage and Jam.

So many of the shows at Bill's Pickin' Parlor are presented for a small donation. "It's important to keep the music affordable for working families," Willie said. Selling top-brand instruments is important, too.

"We sell the best bluegrass instruments you can buy," he said. You'll hear a variety of instruments at Bill's, including the fiddle, dobro, mandolin, and bass. Bill's is also the home of Willie Wells and The Blue Ridge Mountain Grass.
