Maintaining Police and Fire budgets while adding and upgrading equipment to continue to provide efficient and effective emergency response.



Enhancements to City's payment portal for better customer service, notification alerts, and direct access to meter data.



Providing financial resources for improvements to the water and sewer infrastructure throughout West Columbia.



Superior emergency services with the Fire Department maintaining the highest possible ISO rating of "1" in the nation, keeping insurance costs lower for residents and business owners.



Providing expanded operation and maintenance to the water and sewer systems in line with the 2018 plan.



Enhancing public service with additional equipment in public parks, spaces, and sanitation department.



OTHER PRIORITIES INCLUDE:

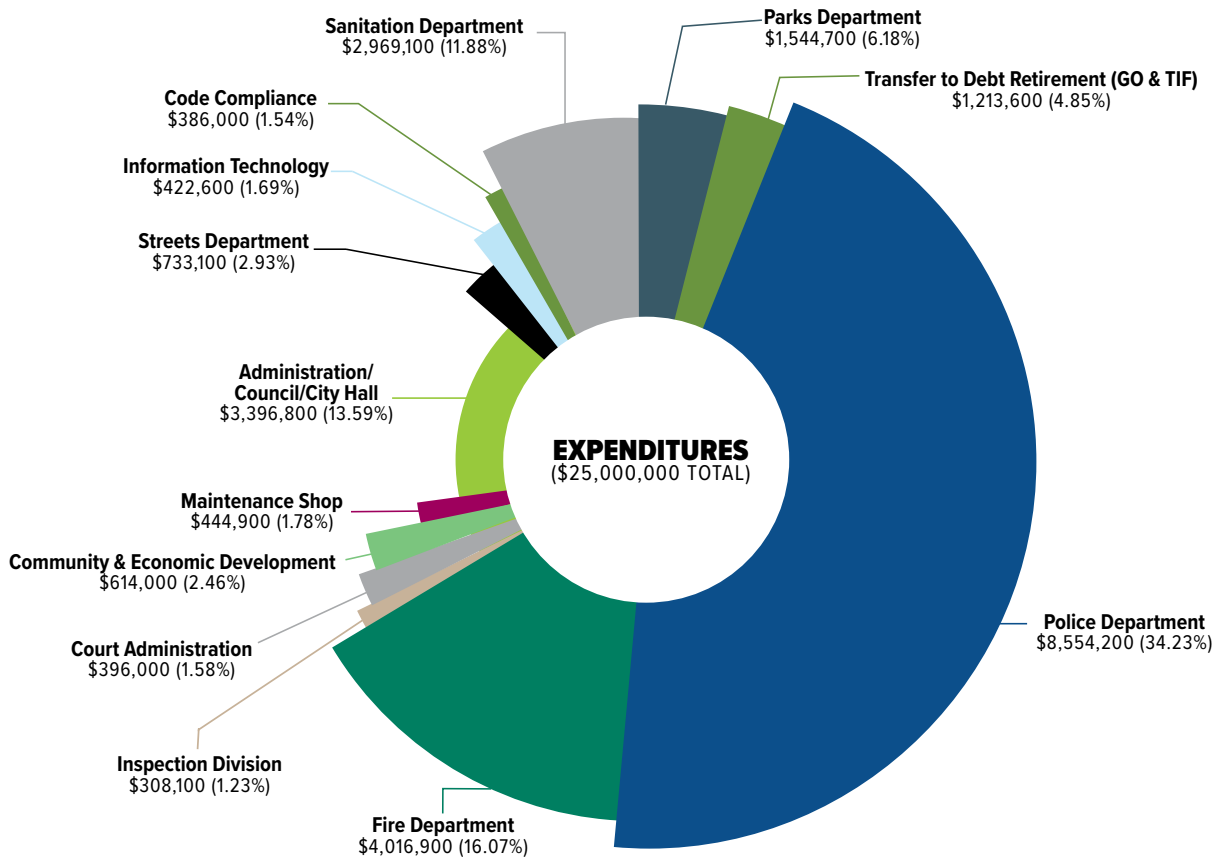
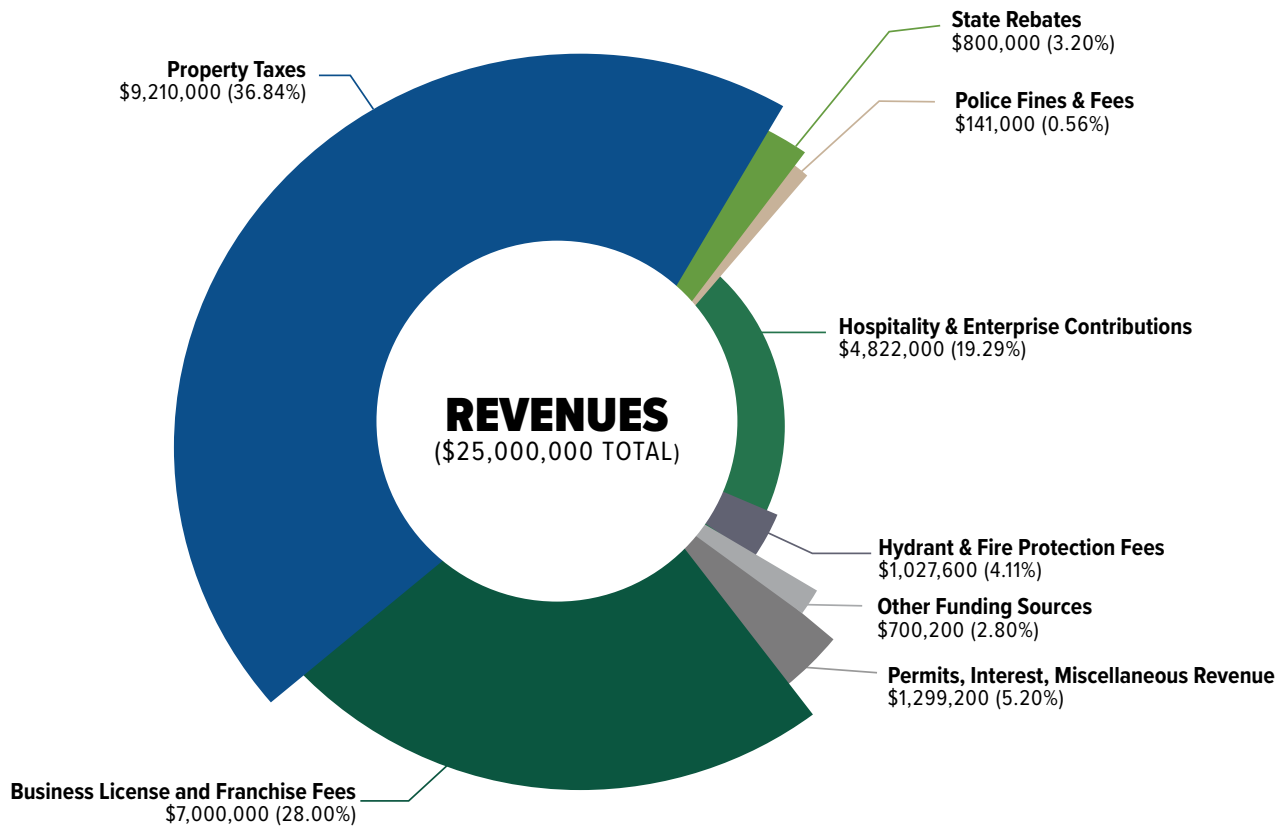
- Maximizing grant opportunities to capitalize on all funding sources
