Sealed Bids for the construction of the Mill Village Area Infrastructure Improvements – Material Procurement will be received, by the City of West Columbia, in the New Brookland room of 200 N. 12th Street, West Columbia, SC, until 2:00 pm local time on Thursday, June 6, 2024 at which time the Bids received will publicly opened and read. Bidders must indicate material delivery schedule with bids.

Bidders on this work will be required to comply with the President’s Executive Order No. 11246 and Order No. 1137 which prohibit discrimination in employment regarding race, creed, color, sex or national origin.

Bidders must comply with Title VI for Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Davis-Bacon Act, the Anti-Kickback Act, the Contract Work Hours and Safety Standards Act, and 40 CFR 33.240.

This project will be constructed with funds provided by Lexington County Community Development Block Grant. All contractors are required to be registered in the Federal System for Award Management.

Bidder must make positive efforts to use small and minority owned businesses and offer employment, training and contracting opportunities in accordance with Section 3 of the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1968.

Bids will be received for a single prime Contract. Bids shall be on a lump sum and unit price basis.
